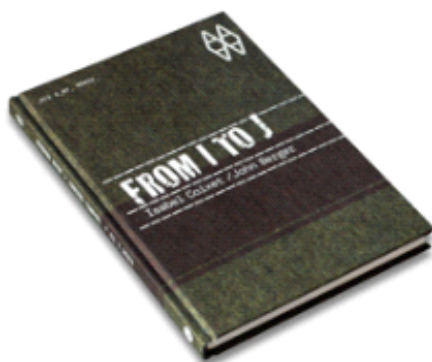

Coixet has created an installation based on Berger's book From a to X, with the collaboration of architect Benedetta Tagliabue and some of the most acclaimed actresses working in film today.
